As in human medicine, anesthetic and surgical procedures have potential complications, including death in rare instances. We highly recommend that pre-anesthetic blood work be performed, and it is included in the price of our elective procedures. This will help insure that your pet is in a low risk category for anesthesia and surgery by ruling out certain preexisting internal problems that may not be evident on a physical exam, such as anemia, which could lead to complications. These tests are similar to what your physician would run if you were to undergo anesthesia. In addition, the results of these tests will serve as reference values for future use should your pet become ill.

HSU VOUCHER CLIENTS: If Pre-anesthetic Bloodwork indicates needing to postpone surgery, the client is fully responsible for paying for pre-anesthetic bloodwork in the amount of \$108.00
